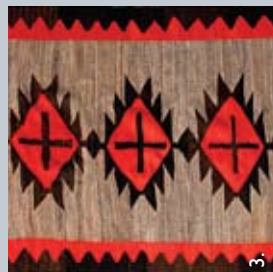

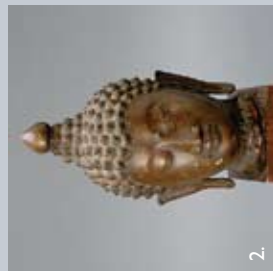

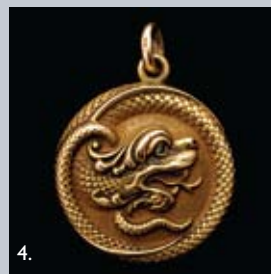

Auction Fundraiser Creekside School for Children with Autism

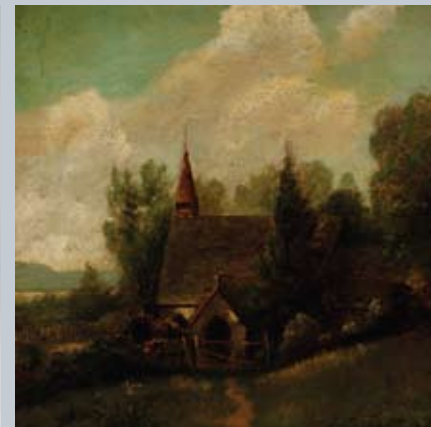
