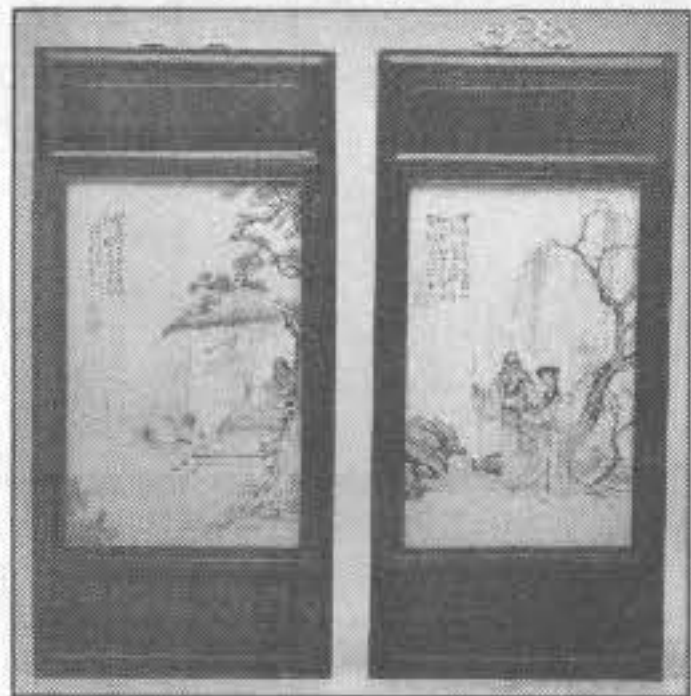


Famille rose plaques, \$463,000, Michaan's



A pair of famille rose porcelain plaques from the Republic period of Wang Qi (1884-1937) sold for \$463,000 at a Fine Asian Works of Art Auction held June 23 by Michaan's Auctions in Alameda, Calif. Also, a folding screen inset with porce-

lain plaques coasted to \$59,000; two huanghuali horse-shoe back armchairs with side table fetched \$100,300; a landscape hanging scroll by Wu Hufan (1894-1968) made \$59,000; a cinnabar lacquer scroll form box brought \$38,350; and a spinach double gourd form wall vase reached \$23,600. Prices include a 17 percent buyer's premium.
