Estate of Barbara Hussey Riggins Coin Collection Marches into Auction

Michaan's presents its first ever stand-alone coin auction on March 6, 2015, featuring pieces of excellence from the estate of Barbara Hussey Riggins. The sale contains over 300 fine coin lots from the estate, with selections spanning high grade, U.S. platinum and gold pieces. The coin collection, which Ms. Riggins started amassing in the early 1950s, has now been sorted into sale lots with an approximate cumulative low estimate of \$500,000. The rare and desirable collection highlights U.S. Liberty Head gold coins such as an 1878-S \$20 MS63 (\$12,000-15,000), an 1887-S \$20 MS63 (\$10,000-12,000) and an 1875 \$20 MS64 (\$10,000-12,000). Michaan's Coin and Stamp Specialist Mr. Michael Rosenberg commented on the aforementioned pieces, stating, "The grading on these coins is very rare; their condition is exceptional, pristine. To find low mint pieces such as these in this condition is undoubtedly a collector's treasure."

Additional price points at auction include two lots of 1914 \$2 ½ Indian Head gold NNC MS64 coins at estimates of \$5,000-7,000 each. These coins are also of a very low total mintage at 240,000. An offering of 3 lots of China Panda Gold and Lunar premium sets will also make an appearance at auction at \$4,000-5,000 each. Also of note is a 1754 Pillar Mexican 8 Reale MS61 silver coin, recovered from a shipwreck at an estimation of \$3,000-5,000.
